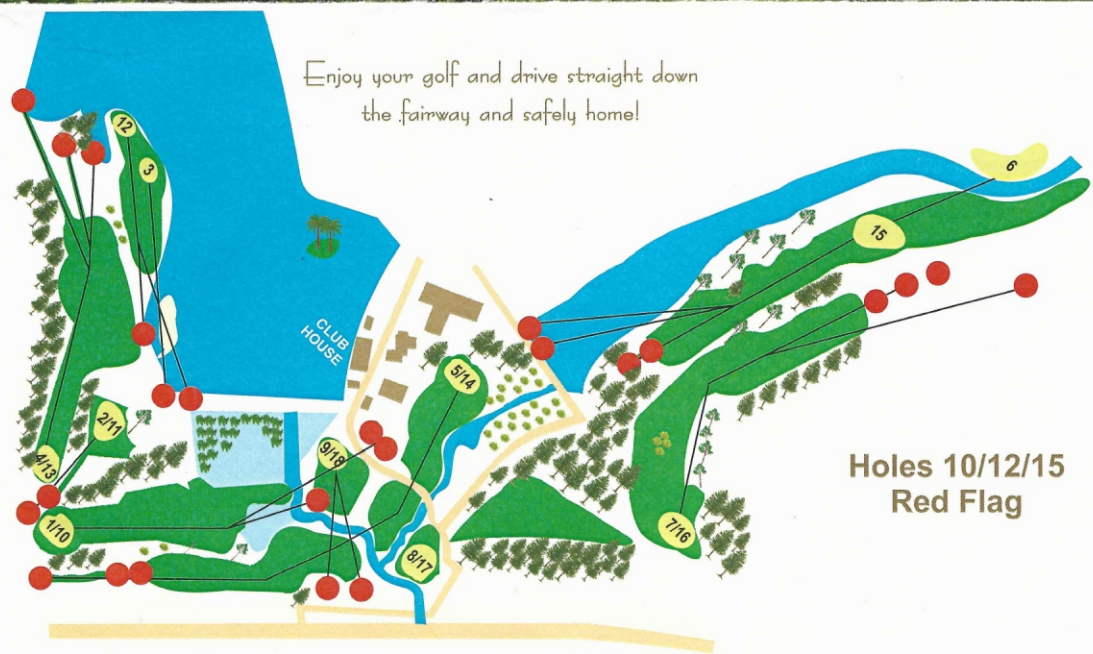

LOCAL RULES REFER TO YOUR MARKER

- Placing is allowed on the fairway in play (1 club length)
- Out of bounds:** a ball is out of bounds when it comes to rest:
 - Beyond all perimeter fences and white posts.
 - On holes 5 & 14 from behind the 1st tee box beyond the white post.
- WATER HAZARDS & STAKED AREAS (Rule 26)**
 - Water hazards are defined by YELLOW stakes
 - Lateral water hazards and penalty areas are defined by RED stakes
 - Environmentally sensitive areas are defined by BLUE stakes*
***(ball must be found, drop nearest point of relief, without penalty)**
- DISTANCES**

All distances are measured from the permanent marker on the T box through the middle of the fairway to the centre of the green.
- PLANTED TREES AND ALOES**

If a young tree under the height of 2m or an aloe interferes with a players stance or stroke, the player MUST drop the ball within one club length not nearer the hole from nearest point of relief without penalty.
- POWER LINES OR CABLES**

If a players ball hits power line cables overhanging the course, the player MUST replay the shot without penalty.
- GUR:** The player MUST drop within a club length from the nearest point of relief - **the ball must be found.**
 - All areas enclosed by a white dotted line or marked GUR
 - Gravelled roads within one club length from the edge of the road.
 - All flower beds
 - Sprinkler heads
 - Electric fence - if the fence interferes with a players stroke or stance the player MUST drop within one club length not nearer the hole from the nearest point of relief.
- Please check the notice board for supplementary local rules.
- Please repair divots, avoid slow play. Play ready golf.
- Please take note of the local weather rule posted on the notice board.
- COUNT OUT HOLES:** 2; 7; 10; 15; 16 and then thereafter second nine holes thereafter the first nine holes.
